#### ATTENDANCE:

Please the call the office or email BOTH Sue Goss-Klecker (sgoss@sd35.bc.ca) AND Cynthia Dobbs Cox (cdobbscox@sd35.bc.ca) if your child is ever away from school. This way, one will be able to mark the absence as excused. There is an auto dial system that will call out if your child is absent without being "Excused". Our school answering machine is always on. Please feel free to leave the school your message at any time of day or night – 604-530-2361 if your child will be absent.

#### **MUNCHALUNCH (Hot Lunch):**

If you are interested, we have a program called MunchALunch which is led by our PAC (Parent Advisory Council) Executive team. This is not mandatory to participate in however, any lunches that you order, partial proceed go to raise funds for our school. #### SCHOOL GROUNDS: INFORMATION Traffic:

- Please follow the signs that are directing traffic in the parking lot.
- Please pay close attention to the crosswalk attendants and to pedestrian traffic.
- Please only park in designated parking spots. There is additional street parking available if the lot is full. Please do not block the driveways of our neighbours or park in no-parking zones or accessible spots if you do not have a SPARC permit.

We do love your pets, but please keep them off school grounds between 8:00 am and 3:30 pm, as well as at school events.

#### SCHOOL MESSENGER – NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

The Langley School District uses a notification system called SchoolMessenger to communicate information to families. As we welcome our new families to our schools, some parents/guardians may receive a text message notifying them about SchoolMessenger. #### VOLUNTEERS

We have many opportunities for parent volunteers at Simonds and U-Connect. All volunteers (INCLUDING DRIVERS) must be approved by administration and must follow school guidelines. All casual volunteers must fill out a Volunteer Safety Check form; which will be given out by our teachers as volunteers are required in classrooms.

Volunteers who will regularly be working with a small group or individual students (ex. Coaching a team or being a parent reader) must provide a Criminal Record Check. New this year, volunteers are required to complete online training if they are regularly volunteering in schools. Volunteers must have their CRC and online training complete before they begin volunteering. #### **PERSONAL DIGITAL DEVICES:**

**Grades K-7**: No personal digital devices to be allowed at school. Students with these devices should keep them at home or they stay 100% of the day from arrival to departure in backpack.

**Grades 8-12:** No personal digital devices during instructional time. Exceptions for medical reasons can be made with consultation between admin and counseling.
